Position Overview

Tent Repair is a separate maintenance department focused on the storage, inventory, and repair of all canvas tents around Philmont Scout Ranch. Prospective candidates within Tent Repair will be participating in warehouse training and care including material storage in excess of a thousand-pound utilizing forklifts and pallet jacks. Receive training and expected to utilized repair materials and industrial sewing machines. Candidates will assist with field operations including responding to field repair issues with platform tents as well as eco-structure tents.

Primary Duties & Responsibilities

- Receive training and be able to utilize powered industrial vehicles
- Receive training on industrial sewing machines and be able to operate responsibly
- Can properly use hand tools and operate powered hand tools
- Have a valid driver license to operate Philmont vehicles and pull trailers
- Successfully complete the Philmont Driver Training Course and use the knowledge gained.
- Complete other duties as assigned by direct supervisor or ranch management as required

Desired Qualifications & Experience

- Any previous experience in utilizing sewing machines or sewing tools
- Some wood-working experience to assist with platform repair
- UTV certified through accredited program
- Valid Driver's License
- Must be able to secure a Philmont driving permit

Physical Requirements & Work Environment

- Must be able to lift 50 pounds on a continuous basis
- Access to all weather gear for various exposures to the elements
- Closed shoes will be required when working in the warehouse
- If known, any allergy to treated canvas must be considered (possibility of being exposed to fire treated material)
- Up to 90% of the workday could be spent standing, walking, bending, stooping, kneeling, or crouching
