Planned sessions include: National, Council and congregation levels of "Duty to God"; P.R.A.Y. and Religious Emblems Programs; Unit and Adult Recognitions; Sharing our Faith with Scouts; Organizing Scouting Units; Selecting Quality Leaders; Duty to God in Advancement; and more. We'll also hold the Annual Meeting of the N.L.A.S. during the conference.
